- ❖ Titus was to teach people, including slaves, to live in a way that would affirm their claim to know God.
- ❖ Paul is addressing slaves, not endorsing slavery.
- ❖ We must do our work with Gospel intentionality.
- ❖ In Titus 2:9-10, Paul presents six principles for godly work that will reveal Christ in our place of service.

1. Be Productive For Your Superior. (v.9)
2. Be Pleasing In Your Spirit. (v.9)
3. Be Polite In Your Speech. (v.9)
4. Be Principled In Your Service. (v.10)
5. Be Public In Your Sincerity. (v.10)
6. Be Praiseworthy For Your Savior. (v.10)
