TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP/BUYER(S) REQUIREMENT- Upon the sale or transfer of a motor vehicle the owner in whose name the certificate of title is issued shall execute a formal transfer of the vehicle. Within 60 days the buyer shall present the certificate of title together with an application for title to an authorized agent pursuant to C.R.S. 42-6-110.

TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP/SELLER(S) REQUIREMENT- When the owner of a motor vehicle transfers or assigns the certificate of title to a buyer, the registration of such vehicle shall expire and the seller shall remove the license plates pursuant to C.R.S. 42-3-115.

ODOMETER CERTIFICATION- Federal and state law requires the seller to declare the mileage of the motor vehicle and requires the buyer to acknowledge the mileage of the motor vehicle upon transfer of ownership. The seller and buyer are required to print and sign their name to acknowledge the mileage pursuant to 49 USC 327.

INTEGRITY FIRST!

Doing the right thing at all times, supervised or not, in spite of pressures to compromise, defines a person's integrity. It is the keystone of military service. Cadets have the opportunity to display the highest standards of integrity each day in the tests they take, in the words they speak, in respecting others and their property, and in upholding the honor of the cadet wing. Here at the Air Force Academy, the foundation is established for a lifetime of service to the nation.

"Integrity is the most important responsibility of command. Commanders are dependent on the integrity of those reporting to them in every decision they make. Integrity can be ordered but it can only be achieved by encouragement and example." - General John D. Ryan, Air Force Chief of Staff, in a policy letter issued in November 1972 following the wake of revelations of false reporting in Vietnam.

THE HONOR CODE

The Honor Code is the proudest tradition of the Academy and has remained unchanged since it was first accepted by the Class of 1959 as the minimum standard. Every cadet entering the Academy must take an oath agreeing to live under the Honor Code. In taking the Oath, cadets pledge to place personal integrity, the interests of the cadet wing and the Air Force ahead of whatever personal advantages might accrue from lying, stealing, cheating or tolerating violations of the code. The Honor Code and system is administered by the Cadet Honor Committee, representatives from the squadron, group and wing levels who are elected by classmates to serve in their positions. Cadets suspected of violating the Honor Code are investigated and their cases go before a board of their peers. Violators of the code receive severe punishments, often including disenrollment. Living under an Honor Code places no further restrictions on Cadet life than what is expected of active-duty officers. Living honorably is vital to maintaining trust and respect between service members. Most graduates agree living under the Honor Code as a cadet was one of the best ways to prepare them for Air Force leadership and life beyond the Academy.


